

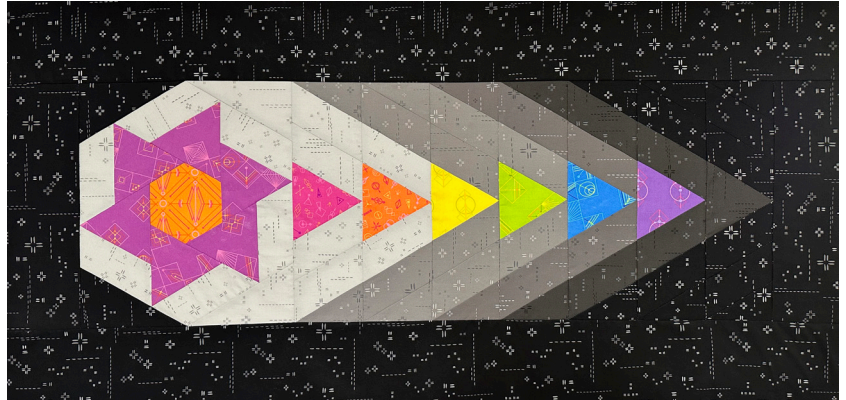
# Shooting Star

## SUPPLY LIST & PRE-WORKSHOP INSTRUCTIONS

**Shooting Star** is a really fun and amazingly fast project to sew! If you're a "60-degree novice", this is a great project to introduce yourself to 60-degree patchwork as there are NO "Y-SEAMS" to sew! If you already love 60-degree shapes, this project is pure 60-degree bliss.



### SUPPLIES:

**-SEWING MACHINE:** provided!

**-THREAD:** 50 wt or 60 wt piecing thread, neutral color

**-KELLYQUILTER ACRYLIC TEMPLATE PROJECT SET:** Templates H2, ET4, LQ4, HET4, & HET6 are required for each student. The cost of the template kit, which also includes anti-skid material, is **\$26, tax included** (Retail value: \$30 before tax), payable to Kelly at the beginning of the workshop (cash or credit / debit card, please).

**ROTARY CUTTER:** 28mm size, preferred

**-CUTTING MAT:** There will be cutting stations in the classroom, *HOWEVER* if you have a small mat (8" square or so) on a rotating base (or even a small regular mat) please bring it.

**-RULER:** Your favorite ruler for cutting width-of-fabric strips (6-8.5" x 18"-24.5"). You'll use this for pre-workshop prep AND please bring to class.

**-NOTIONS:** pins, seam ripper, thread snips, any other favorite notions

**-MAGIC Premium Quilting & Crafting Spray** (my personal favorite) or Mary Ellen's Best Press (for pre-workshop fabric preparation - see next page)

**-FABRIC:** quilters' cottons or batiks (no flannels or lawns, please) See table below.

<b>Fabric Requirements</b> (based on 41" of usable fabric width)	
<b>Star Center Hexagon and Colorful Triangle Tail</b>	Seven 5" squares (or larger)- a variety of different colors
<b>Star Points</b>	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard - color contrasting with center hexagon
<b>Very Light Grey</b>	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard non-directional fabric
<b>Light Grey</b>	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard - non-directional fabric
<b>Medium Grey</b>	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard - non-directional fabric
<b>Dark Grey</b>	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard - non-directional fabric
<b>Charcoal or Black (includes yardage for binding)</b>	1 yard
<b>Batting</b>	rectangle at least 24 x 44"
<b>Backing</b>	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard

### **Pre-Workshop Fabric Preparation and Pre-cutting:**

**Please complete these steps *before* class.**

**STEP 1:** Prepare all of your quilt top fabrics by generously (quite damp; not dripping wet) spritzing them with Magic Premium Quilting / Crafting Spray (or Mary Ellen's Best Press) to add body and mild stiffness to the fabric, then press the fabric until dry with a dry iron on cotton setting. Or, if you prefer, you can spritz the fabrics, iron them briefly, then hang them until completely dry. Once dry, press out the wrinkles using a steam iron on cotton setting.

### **STEP 2:**

- Bring the fabrics for the **Star Center**, **Triangle Tail**, and the **Very Light Grey** to class as prepped.
- From the **Star Points** fabric, cut one strip, 4" x WOF (width of fabric)
- From the **Light Grey** fabric, cut one strip, 4" x WOF

## STEP 2 (continued):

- From the **Medium Grey** fabric, cut one strip, 4" x WOF
  - From the **Dark Grey** fabric, cut one strip, 4" x WOF
  - From the **Charcoal / Black** fabric, cut:
    - one strip, 4" x WOF
    - one strip, 5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF
    - four strips, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF for binding; set aside \*
    - two strips, 4" x WOF for upper & lower border strips \*
    - two strips, 3" x WOF for side border strips \*
- \* You needn't bring these strips to class.

Please bring **ALL quilt top fabrics / cut strips** (except those marked with an *asterisk*) to class.
